

These are the guidelines all are asked to adhere to for us to be able to assemble in-person indoors

- Stay home if you are sick or at-risk
- We ask that all wear a face covering
- One in-person indoor assembly at 9 AM Sunday
- You may bring children, but keep your children close-by (parents may want to bring activities from home for children as there will be no handouts)
- Observe spatial distancing and hand-sanitizing
- Groups of same household sit together only. If alone please sit on one end of a row allowing for someone else to sit on the other end (this leaves two chairs separating you).
- Communion will be available in pre-filled cups
- A contribution lockbox will be available for collection—no passing of plates
- Any bulletins or sermon notes handed out must be taken home or thrown away (they will also be e-mailed as PDFs or you can scan a QR code to download the bulletin to your phone/tablet)
- One online only assembly at 11 AM Sunday
- No in-person adult or children's classes
 - ZOOM Adult class 6 pm Sunday
 - ZOOM Adult class 7 pm Wednesday
 - ZOOM Children's Class 4 pm Friday (ages 8-12)
- All other meetings and activities inside the church building remain suspended until further notice.

All of these precautions will be evaluated as more information becomes available. We will communicate any changes as decisions are made. Thank you so much for your patience.
